

The City of Hillsboro Kansas is accepting bids for concrete rubble crushing until February 11, 2021 at 12:00 pm. Bids can be sent to the below address or e-mailed to: jmeisinger@cityofhillsboro.net.

Concrete rubble pile is located at City of Hillsboro Maintenance Yard at 615 N Adams in Hillsboro.

There is an estimated 9,000 tons concrete with approximately 7% asphalt mixed in. There is also an estimated 800 tons of asphalt to be crushed and piled separate. The city has a 1" yard hydrant onsite or a fire hydrant fill available off site at no charge.

Crushing requirements:

- 400 tons of concrete to be crushed at 3"
- Remainder concrete to be crushed at 1 ½" minus
- Wire and steel to be removed and hauled offsite by contractor
- Crushing needs to be completed by May 21, 2021
- Contractor needs to have 2 working magnets to remove steel

All bids must include the following:

- State price per ton for concrete 3"
- State price per ton for concrete 1 1/2" minus
- State price per ton for asphalt
- State approximate crushing dates
- State method for measuring completed piles or weights across a belt
- State any mobilization fees
- Please state references for recent piles that your agency crushed available for inspection
- Copy of the liability insurance for the company

Once selected, the City will require an approved agreement with the selected contractor for the work to be completed. For any additional information please contact:
