

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, KANSAS TO LEVY A  
PROPERTY TAX RATE EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE.

WHEREAS, the revenue neutral rate for the City of Hillsboro, Kansas ("City") has been calculated as 40.886 mills by the Marion County, Kansas Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the budget proposed by the Governing Body of the City will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the revenue neutral rate; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that proper notice was given and a public hearing was held on September 7, 2021, all as provided by law pursuant to 2021 Kansas Legislature Senate Bill No. 13, related to exceeding the revenue neutral rate; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City finds it necessary and advisable to exceed the revenue neutral rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Exceed Revenue Neutral Rate. The City is hereby authorized to levy property taxes to exceed the revenue neutral rate of 40.886 mills.


SECTION 2. City Clerk Authorization. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to take action as may be reasonably necessary in connection with and in support of the City's authorization to exceed the revenue neutral rate, including but not limited to, providing certification to the Marion County, Kansas Clerk of the taxes to be levied, and executing such related documents.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption and passage by the Governing Body of the City.
