ORDINANCE NO. 1245

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, KANSAS, REPEALING AND REPLACING ARTICLE 1 OF CHAPTER II OF ORDINANCE 1020, COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE CODE OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, KANSAS, 2000, RELATED TO THE KEEPING OR HARBORAGE OF LIVESTOCK AND FOWL WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, KANSAS, THAT THE FOLLOWING CODE SECTIONS SHALL BE ADOPTED, AND SHALL REPEAL AND REPLACE ARTICLE 1 OF CHAPTER II OF ORDINANCE 1132, THE CODE OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, KANSAS, 2000.

CHAPTER II: ARTICLE 1, LIVESTOCK AND FOWL GENERALLY

2-101. DEFINITION OF LIVESTOCK. Any member of the horse family, jackass family, swine family, sheep family, goat family or any species of cattle.

2-102. DEFINITION OF FOWL. Any member of the species *Gallus domesticus*, any pigeon, any species of peafowl or any bird used for food or hunted as game.

2-103. PROHIBITION ON KEEPING OR HARBORING LIVESTOCK AND FOWL.

It shall be unlawful to keep, harbor, shelter or maintain livestock or fowl within the corporate city limits. Exceptions:

2-103.1 Livestock and fowl under direct supervision of and upon the premises of fairs, livestock shows, rodeos or circuses shall be exempt from this restriction.

2-103.2 Livestock and fowl under the supervision of an educational institution.

2-104. LIVESTOCK, FOWL AT LARGE. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to permit or allow any livestock or fowl to run at large within the city or to picket or drive any livestock or fowl in or upon any street, avenue, lane, alley or other public ground within the city. Exception: Livestock and fowl under direct supervision of and upon the premises of fairs, livestock shows, rodeos or circuses shall be exempt from this restriction.
