

ORDINANCE NO. 1313

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 1174 SETTING THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF TERMS OF OFFICE FOR MEMBERS OF CITIZEN BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

WHEREAS, the effective performance of local government depends on the willingness of citizens to volunteer and serve on boards and commission of the City of Hillsboro.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hillsboro, Kansas recognizes the ever increasing need of specialized knowledge and skills to effectively lead citizen boards and commissions the growth and expansion of those boards and commissions and the importance of experience on those boards and commissions and the importance of their advice and recommendations to the City Council.

WHEREAS, the City of Hillsboro intends this ordinance to apply to all current and future boards an commission advising the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, KANSAS:

Section 1.Repeal. Ordinance 1174 Establishing term limits for members of boards and commissions for the City of Hillsboro is repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. No Term Limits. Members of City of Hillsboro boards and commissions shall not be limited to a maximum number of terms. Nothing herein shall serve to modify the length of each term for any board or commission.

Section 3. Invalidity of a part. Any provisions of this Ordinance which shall be declared to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid shall not affect the validity and authority of any other section of said Ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication once in the official city newspaper.
