ORDINANCE NO. 1376

AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES (50<sup>th</sup> EDITION); AMENDING CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 14-101 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-3009 *et seq.* and K.S.A. 12-3301 *et seq.*, all as amended, the City of Hillsboro, Kansas (the “City”) desires to incorporate by reference the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities (50<sup>th</sup> Edition), as published by the League of Kansas Municipalities in 2023 (the “STO”), with certain modifications, as previously and hereafter set forth in the Code of the City of Hillsboro, Kansas (the “Code”); and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City finds it advisable to incorporate the STO by reference and to amend the Code to reflect incorporation of the STO.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, MARION COUNTY, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance incorporating the STO supersedes and repeals Ordinance No. 1359, but solely to the extent Ordinance No. 1359 incorporated the previous version of the STO, and any and all previous ordinances similar thereto or the incorporation of previous versions thereof. Any remaining provisions of Ordinance No. 1359 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 2. The City hereby incorporates by reference the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities (50<sup>th</sup> Edition), as published by the League of Kansas Municipalities in 2023, with certain deletions and modifications as set forth in the Code. Accordingly, Section 14-101 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Section 14-101. Incorporating standard traffic ordinance.**

Pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 12-3009 *et seq.*, and K.S.A. 12-3301 *et seq.*, the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities (50<sup>th</sup> Edition), as published by the League of Kansas Municipalities in 2023 (the “Standard Traffic Ordinance”), is hereby adopted by reference, as if said model or standard ordinance were set out in full herein, save and except such sections, parts, or portions as may be omitted or deleted, modified, or changed elsewhere within the Code of the City of Hillsboro, Kansas.

No fewer than one (1) copy of said Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped “Official Copy as incorporated in the Code of the City of Hillsboro, Kansas by Ordinance No. 1376” and shall be filed in the City Clerk’s office and open for public

inspection at all reasonable office hours. The police department, municipal judge and all administrative departments of the City charged with enforcement of the Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the City, such number of official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance, similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is hereby instructed to maintain no fewer than one (1) copy of the STO to be made available for public inspection at all reasonable office hours. The City Clerk shall mark or stamp on all copies stating "Official Copy as incorporated in the Code of the City of Hillsboro, Kansas by Ordinance No. 1376" with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted clearly marked to show any such omission or showing the sections, articles, chapters, parts or portions that are incorporated, as the case may be, and to which shall be attached a copy of this incorporating ordinance, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-3010.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by the Governing Body of the City, approval by the Mayor and either (a) publication once in the official newspaper of the City, or (b) publication of a summary hereof certified as legally accurate and sufficient by the City Attorney.
