ORDINANCE NO. 1276

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF COURT COSTS AND FEES FOR THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, KANSAS AFTER HAVING CHARTERD OUT OF K.S.A. 12-4112.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO KANSAS:

Section 1. COSTS. Unless otherwise prohibited by City ordinance or Kanas law, persons who plead no contest, plead guilty, or who are convicted shall be assessed costs for the administration of justice in any municipal court case, including:

- a) Each case without regard to the number of counts\$66.50
- b) For mileage, subpoena, and witness costs for defense witnesses:
 - a. Per day or any part thereof for an appearance\$5.00
 - b. Plus, per mile actually driven over 5 miles, reimbursement consistent with the Internal Revenue Service allowed rate.
 - c. State mandated fee including but not limited to:
 - i. Judicial branch education fund (K.S.A. 12-4116 and amendments thereto): Each case, without regard to the number of counts, shall be assessed an amount fixed by order of the State Supreme Court. Funds collected pursuant to this assessment shall be distributed as required by state law.
 - ii. Local Law enforcement funds, (as required by state law K.S.A. 12-4117 and amendments hereto): Each case, without regard to the number of counts, charging a criminal or public offense or charging an offense defined as a traffic offense pursuant to state law shall be assessed an amount fixed by state law. Funds collected shall be distribute as required by state law.

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication in the official city newspaper, or January 1, 2017 which ever is later.
