

ORDINANCE NO. 1259

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING A PORTION OF ORDINANCE 1224 THAT ADOPTED THE INTERNATIONAL ENERGY CONSERVATION CODE

WHEREAS: Ordinance 1224 was approved December 4, 2012 that amended Chapter IV, Section 4-202 approving the 2012 Editions of the International Building Code, the International Residential Code and the international Energy Conservation Code, and

WHEREAS: The City Council determined it to be in the best interest of the community to rescind the International Energy Conservation Code.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO:

Section 1. Article IV, Section 4-202 shall be amended to read:
INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE INCORPORATION. There is hereby adopted and incorporated by reference, for the purpose of establishing rules and regulations for the construction, alteration, removal demolition, equipment, use and occupancy, location and maintenance of buildings and structures, the International Building Code and International Residential Code, 2012 Edition, as recommended by the International Conference of Building Officials, such code being made as a part of the ordinances and code of the city as if the same had been set out in full herein, all as authorized and in the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-3009 through 12-3012 including any amendments thereto. No fewer than three copies of the International Building Code and the International Residential Code 2012 Edition, shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Incorporated by the City of Hillsboro," and shall be filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours of business.

Any person violating any provision of such code shall be punished as provided in Section 1-116 of this code.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take after publication.
