ORDINANCE 1231

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS RELATED TO THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE 2012 INTERNATIONAL PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE.

WHEREAS, THE City Council of the City of Hillsboro, Kansas, adopted the 2012 International Property Maintenance Code by Ordinance 1224 on December 4, 2012; and,

WHEREAS, the City wishes to set the penalties for violations of said code.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Penalties:

- As prescribed by Section 106, of the 2012 International Property Maintenance Code, adopted by the City of Hillsboro thru Ordinance Number 1224 and any future edition of said code similarly adopted, the following penalties for violation of the code are established:
- 2. Should any person fail to either comply with the notice and correction order or request a hearing, or should any person following a requested appeal, fail to comply with any order which is then issued by the board of appeals, within the time prescribed by the board of appeals, the city clerk, the chief of police or the code official may file a complaint in the municipal court of the city against such person. Conviction of any violation of provisions of this code shall be punishable by a fine in an amount not to exceed \$500, or by imprisonment not to exceed three months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- 3. Each day that a violation continues after notice has been served shall be deemed a separate offense.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effective upon publication in the official city newspaper.
