ORDINANCE NO. 1232

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "2013 UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES" 29th EDITION; REPEALING SECTION 12-101 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, KANSAS; REPEALING ORDINANCE 1220; AND CONFIRMING ALL OTHER PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER XII OF SAID CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, KANSAS:

Section 1. INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Hillsboro, Kansas, that certain code known as the "2013 Uniform Public Offense Code", 29th Edition, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 1232", and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

Section 2. All other provisions of Chapter XII of the Code of the City of Hillsboro, Kansas, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take full force and effect from and after its publication one time in the *Hillsboro Star Journal*, the official city newspaper.
