ORDINANCE NO. 1377

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES (39th EDITION), AS PUBLISHED BY THE LEAGUE OF KANSAS MUNICIPALITIES IN 2023; AND AMENDING CHAPTER 11, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 11-101 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-3009 *et seq.*, and K.S.A. 12-3301 *et seq.*, all as amended, the City of Hillsboro, Kansas (the "City") desires to incorporate by reference the Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities (39th Edition), as published by the League of Kansas Municipalities in 2023 (the "UPOC"), and as set forth in the Code of the City of Hillsboro, Kansas (the "Code"); and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City finds it advisable to incorporate the UPOC by reference and to amend the Code to reflect incorporation of the latest UPOC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, MARION COUNTY, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance incorporating the UPOC supersedes and repeals Ordinance No. 1358, but solely to the extent Ordinance No. 1358 incorporated the previous UPOC, and any and all previous ordinances similar thereto or incorporating previous editions thereof. Any remaining provisions of Ordinance No. 1358 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 2. The City hereby incorporates by reference the Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities (39th Edition), as published by the League of Kansas Municipalities in 2023. Accordingly, Section 11-101 of Chapter 11, Article 1 of the Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

11-101. Incorporating uniform public offense code.

Pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 12-3009 *et seq.*, and K.S.A. 12-3301 *et seq.*, the Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities (39th Edition), as prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas in 2023 (the "Uniform Public Offense Code"), is hereby adopted by reference, as if said model or standard code were set out in full herein, save and except such sections, parts, or portions as may be omitted or deleted, modified, or changed elsewhere within the Code of the City of Hillsboro, Kansas.

The City Clerk of Hillsboro, Kansas shall prepare and make one (1) copy of said Uniform Public Offense Code, by marking or stamping thereon "Official Copy as incorporated by Ordinance No. 1377" with any sections or portions intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show such omission, and to which shall be attached a copy of this Ordinance and filed with the City Clerk to be open for inspection and available to the public at all reasonable business hours.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is hereby instructed to maintain no fewer than one (1) copy of the UPOC to be made available for public inspection at all reasonable office hours. The City Clerk shall mark or stamp on all copies stating "Official Copy as incorporated by Ordinance No. 1377." The City Clerk's office shall, in each of the UPOC copies, place a sticker reflecting any amendments to the UPOC and paste a copy of this Ordinance inside the back cover.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by the Governing Body of the City, approval by the Mayor and either (a) publication once in the official newspaper of the City, or (b) publication of a summary hereof certified as legally accurate and sufficient by the City Attorney.
